HEERF II: CRRSAA Reporting

Saint Michael College of Allied Health's CRRSAA HEERF II grant is \$127,252.00.

The HEERF II is authorized by the Coronavirus response and relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), Public Law 116-260, which was signed into law on December 27, 2020. The CRRSAA provides \$81.88 billion in support for education, including \$22.7 billion to distribute to institutions of higher education in order to "prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus" through the HEERF grants.

The information about Saint Michael College of Allied Health's CRRSAA HEERF II grant is as follows:

CRRSAA HEERF Student Aid: \$127,870.00

Eligibility

These funds are available to provide grants to students for expenses related to the disruption campus operations due to the coronavirus. A student's financial need may have increased based on recent events related to the coronavirus pandemic. Eligible expenses would include food, housing, technology, course materials, health care, and childcare.

- Students must meet Title IV eligibility requirements in order to receive an emergency grant.
- Students must remain on active status and in good standing.
- Students are required to complete the emergency funds request form attesting to the financial need has been caused by the coronavirus pandemic and commitment to use the funds as stated.

Allocation for Distribution

Saint Michael College of Allied Health will distribute \$127,870.00 equally and directly to students based on the number of applicants received that meet the qualifications with a minimum of \$1,000.00 per student. The payments will be paid to students by check. The college is to ensure funds are distributed as widely as possible; therefore, funds will be distributed to all eligible students evenly. The college has distributed \$ 1,000.00 to 104 students which makes the total amount distributed to date is \$104,000.00. However, the remaining funds of \$23,870.00 will be distributed to the remaining eligible students before the end of the next quarter report.
